Assembly Instructions

- Install all 3 parts of the mop handle together.
- Align the blue disc base with the mop head ring.



Using both feet, step on the disc base to snap in the mop head until you hear a "CLICK".



Mop Head Removal Instructions



OR



Step on the microfiber with two feet, then pull up the handle with both hands until the disc base is detached from the mop head.



Step on the microfiber where your foot faces the screw. Push the handle away until the disc base snaps off.





Do not step on the blue disc base while pulling the handle up. This could permanently damage the disc base.

Operating Instructions as Wet Mop

- Flip the white lever down to "SPIN & MOP" and leave it there during mopping.
- Straighten the mop handle while stepping on the disc base.
- Rinse the mop head and pull it out slowly to ensure that all strands are straight.








Place all microfiber strands inside the wringer. Then, push the handle up and down a few times to spin dry the mop head.





Step on the disc base to angle the handle, then start mopping.





Do not use the mop as a scrubbing tool with excessive pressure on the handle. Otherwise it may get bent and stop spinning.

Quick Tips



Mops heads are machine washable up to 300X. Use delicate wash cycle then air dry.



Sweep or vacuum prior to wet mopping.



Use water or any cleaning solution of your choice. Avoid using bleach.



Flip the white lever up only when cleaning windows or walls.
